

## What is SkinBase Hydro?

 A non-invasive treatment designed to cleanse, exfoliate, purify, hydrate and revitalise skin.

• The Hydro treatment involves the use of both an exfoliating peel and a personalised serum.

 The peel incorporates a natural blend of AHAs and BHAs to rid the skin of dead cells, impurities and debris, for an instantly fresher complexion.

 Then, an infusion of powerful active ingredients are targeted into the skin via the personalised serum, to combat your specific skin concerns.







## **How Does Hydro Work?**

During a Hydro treatment, a multi-step process of a cleanse, peel, serum and skincare is used.


#### Vacuum Action

- The peel and serum ingredients are delivered effectively into the skin with a vacuum action.
- The vacuum enhances absorption, stimulates blood flow and promotes detoxification.











# How Many Hydro Treatments Do I Need?

### 1 Treatment:

For an instant skin boost to achieve a healthy glow before a big event.

#### 3-6 Treatments:

When treating specific skin concerns we recommend a course of 3-6 treatments to maximise results and achieve healthy skin.

#### 7+ Treatments:

If you have very problematic skin, you may require more than 6 sessions before moving onto a monthly maintenance plan.





# Dull Skin, Uneven Skin Tone & Hyperpigmentation

- Reduce the appearance of discolouration or brighten your dull skin with SkinBase Hydro.
- The peel solution gently exfoliates, allowing superficial pigmentation to be shed.

- 4. SkinBase Skincare







## **Step Three: Personalised Serum**


Your SkinBase therapist will pass the vacuum handset across the treatment area to infuse the selected serum deep into the skin, allowing the active ingredients to get to work immediately.









- Salicylic Acid A versatile beta hydroxy acid (BHA) that penetrates deep into your pores to unclog and exfoliate away dead skin cells.
  - Mandelic Acid A gentle alpha hydroxy acid (AHA) that activates cell turnover to reveal brighter, clearer skin.
  - Lactic Acid An exfoliating AHA that promotes the shedding of dead skin cells to soften and smooth your skin.
  - Glycolic Acid An AHA that exfoliates your skin while maintaining a natural pH balance.
  - Arginine A fabulous ingredient that speeds up cell regeneration and boosts collagen production so you can achieve visibly brighter skin.



- Hyaluronic Acid A skincare superstar that occurs naturally within your skin and acts like a sponge - holding up to 1000x its own weight in water.
- Lactic Acid A fantastic ingredient that promotes hydration, minimises wrinkles, improves texture and increases the firmness of your skin.
- Hydrolysed Soybean Extract Soybean positively influences moisture balance, filling wrinkles from within while smoothing and regenerating your skin.
- Dimethyl MEA Derived from Vitamin B, this ingredient works wonders by adding fullness, reducing facial lines, hydrating, and strengthening collagen.
- Decarboxy Carnosine Hcl Maintains collagen levels within your skin while warding off the negative effects of environmental stressors.



- Niacinamide A versatile skincare hero which will renew and restore your skin by tightening pores and diminishing dullness for a more even skin tone.
- 3-0-Ethyl Ascorbic Acid A form of Vitamin C that fades hyperpigmentation, provides protection from free radicals and brightens your skin.
- Kojic Acid With antioxidant, anti-inflammatory and anti-viral properties to prevent the formation of melanin and treat pigmentation and dark spots.
- Glycolic Acid A naturally occurring exfoliant that renews the surface of your skin by shedding dead skin cells. Also provides skin with significant hydration.
- Glycine Soja Oil A great anti-oxidant and emollient, perfect for smoothing your skin, preventing water loss and fading stubborn pigmentation.



- Niacinamide With anti-inflammatory properties, it renews and restores skin by repairing past damage, minimising sebum and improving your skin barrier.
  - Barosma Betulina Leaf Extract A natural ingredient that regulates excess oils,
     refines pores and mattifies shine to improve the appearance of your skin.
  - Arnica Montana Flower Extract With anti-inflammatory properties, it
    naturally accelerates tissue healing to quickly clear any breakout symptoms.
  - Arctium Majus Root Extract Acts as a sebum regulator and skin purifier, while improving the quality and texture of your skin with its soothing properties.
  - Citric Acid Promotes exfoliation and cell turnover, while restoring moisture to your skin to treat breakouts.





# 1. Flexible to Suit Individual Skin Types

The treatment is suitable for all skin tones and skin types, and can be personalised with the choice of serums to treat specific skin concerns.

## 2. Incredibly Effective

The combination of natural AHAs, BHAs and active ingredients within the peel and serums are incredibly effective, allowing you to see and feel a difference in your skin immediately.

## 3. Enhanced Product Absorption

The peel solution removes dead cells and impurities off your skin, removing barriers to absorption and enhancing the penetration of the serums, and any post-treatment skincare.

## 4. Suitable for the Face and Body

The Hydro treatment can be used across the face and the body, on all skin types and skin tones, so you can easily treat skin concerns.



## **Hydro Pre-Treatment Advice**

#### The Day Of Treatment:

- Avoid wearing makeup on the day of your Hydro treatment if possible to maximise results. Wearing makeup can affect the cleaning process, potentially influencing the effectiveness of the treatment.
- Avoid exposing your skin to the sun before your treatment. Use a broad spectrum SPF, such as the SkinBase Daily Protect SPF, to avoid increased skin sensitivity.

#### 24 Hours Before Treatment:

• Allow 24 hours after waxing/shaving the treatment area before having the Hydro treatment. Waxing/shaving can increase skin sensitivity and cause irritation.

## **Hydro Pre-Treatment Advice**

#### **48/72 Hours Before Treatment**

- Wait 48 hours after using retinoids/exfoliating products before having the Hydro treatment as exfoliants can be too harsh on the skin, causing irritation.
- Schedule your Hydro treatment 48/72 hours before any big events that you are prepping for to ensure any mild side effects, such as redness or peeling, have time to subside.

### 7 Days Before Treatment:

• Allow 7 days after having a facial or a peel (less than 20%) before having the hydro treatment. Facials/Peels can cause irritation or redness.

## **Hydro Pre-Treatment Advice**

#### 14 Days Before Treatment

- If you have had botox or dermal fillers, allow 14 days before having a Hydro treatment to give the botox/fillers time to settle.
- If you have completed a course of laser treatments, wait at least 2 weeks before commencing SkinBase Hydro treatments. Ensure lesions are healed and any swelling or redness is resolved.

#### **4 Weeks Before Treatment:**

• If you have had a 20% or higher peel, wait 4 weeks before having the Hydro treatment.

## **Hydro Aftercare**

#### **For 12 Hours After Treatment**

No heavy makeup.

#### **For 24 Hours After Treatment**

No swimming, no facial waxing.

#### **For 48 Hours After Treatment:**

 No sauna, sun beds, or sun exposure. No botox, collagen injections or dermal fillers.



#### For 72 Hours After Treatment

- Avoid using active ingredients on the skin.
- Do not use anti-ageing creams, AHA's, Glycolics or Retinol.
- Do not use exfoliating products. Exfoliants after treatment can irritate the skin.

### **At All Times During Treatment**

- SPF 30 minimum must be applied and exposure to UV should be avoided.
- Regular moisturiser applications are vital to replenish moisture and prevent the skin from becoming dry and peeling.
